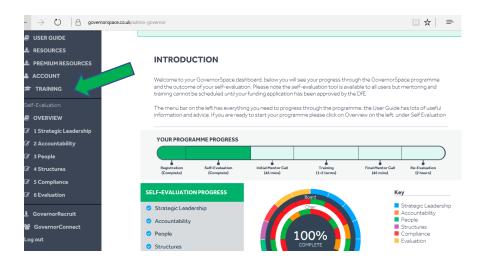
Additional Mentor Support

- 2. Click TRAINING from your dashboard.

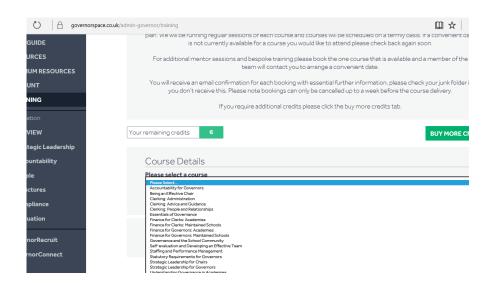




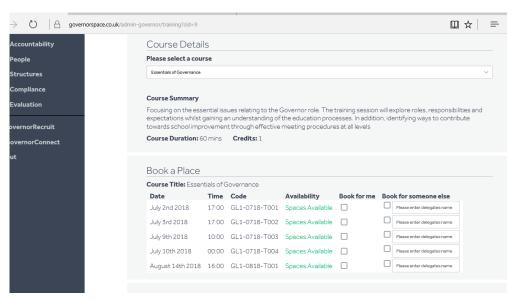




3. Choose an online/recorded/exclusive training session or additional mentor call from the list. View the next pages of this guidance to view training descriptions and dates and times available to book.
